



# INTERNET SET-UP GUIDE

Follow these easy steps to connect your PC to your Internet connection.

## Connection

1. Connect PC or Laptop to the Internet port (RJ45) on the wall with a category 5 or greater Ethernet cable.
2. Update network connection settings – See below. To connect to the Internet with an always-on connection, usernames and passwords are not required.

## Settings - Create new

### Generic for 98, 2000, ME, XP operating systems

1. Click 'Start'
2. Click 'Run'
3. Type 'inetwiz'
4. Click 'Ok'
5. Select 'Connect using my local area network (LAN)'
6. Click 'Next'
7. Select 'Automatic discovery of proxy server'
8. Click 'Next'
9. When asked 'Do you want to set up an Internet Mail account now?'
10. Type 'No'
11. Click 'Next'
12. Click "Finish"
13. Open the 'Control Panel'
14. Open 'Network Connections'
15. Click on the LAN connection, right click, and click 'properties'
16. Click on 'Internet Protocol'
17. Click 'Properties'
18. Select 'Obtain an IP address automatically.'
19. Select 'Obtain DNS server address automatically.'
20. Click 'OK'
21. Click 'OK'
22. Open 'Internet Explorer'
23. Drag down the 'Tools' menu
24. Click 'Internet Options'
25. Click the 'Connections' Tab.
26. Ensure the 'Never dial a connection' option is checked.
27. Click 'Setup'
28. Click 'Next'
29. Click 'Connect to the internet'
30. Click 'Set up my connection manually'
31. Click 'Connect using a broadband connection that is always on'
32. Click 'Finish'

Your Internet connection should now be working.

### If you have Microsoft Vista as an operating system

1. Open Internet Explorer
2. Click "Tools"
3. Click "Internet Options"
4. Click "Connections"
5. Click "LAN settings"
6. Follow instructions from 6 above

### If you use Apple OS

Apple will find its own settings.
